Congratulations!

Passing the test is a major achievement. It shows you understand Canada's history, government, geography, rights, responsibilities, symbols, and values.



IRCC Continues Processing

IRCC reviews your application, verifies documents, and may request additional information.



Receive Your Ceremony Invitation

You'll get an invitation with the date, time, location (or online details), and important instructions.



Take the Oath of Citizenship

At the ceremony, you'll take the Oath and promise to respect Canada's laws and be loyal to Canada.



Get Your Citizenship Certificate

After the ceremony, you'll receive your official Citizenship Certificate. Keep it in a safe place.



Apply for a Canadian Passport

After becoming a citizen, you may apply for a Canadian passport and travel the world with pride.

- ✓ Vote in elections (if eligible)
- ✓ Become more involved in your community
- ✓ Run for public office (if eligible)
- ✓ Continue learning and contributing to Canada

Passing the Canadian citizenship test is a major achievement. It means you've successfully demonstrated your knowledge of Canada and taken another important step toward becoming a Canadian citizen.

Many applicants wonder what happens after they pass the test. This guide explains the next steps and what you can expect.

Congratulations on Passing!

Passing the test is an exciting milestone.

It shows that you understand:

- Canadian history
- Government
- Geography
- Rights and responsibilities
- National symbols
- Canadian values

However, the citizenship process may include additional steps before citizenship is officially granted.



What Happens Next?

After you pass the citizenship test, **IRCC** continues reviewing your application.

Depending on your circumstances, they may:

- Confirm that all application requirements have been met.
- Review your documents.
- Complete any remaining processing.
- Contact you if additional information is required.

Every application is unique, so processing times may vary.



Watch Your Email and Mail

Keep checking:

- ✓ Your IRCC online account (if applicable).
- ✓ Your email inbox.
- ✓ Your regular mail.

IRCC will use these methods to communicate important updates about your application.



Citizenship Ceremony Invitation

Once your application is approved, you'll receive an invitation to attend your Canadian Citizenship Ceremony.

Your invitation will include:

- Ceremony date
- Time
- Location or online meeting details
- Instructions on what to bring

Read the invitation carefully and follow all instructions.



The Oath of Citizenship

At the ceremony, you'll take the **Oath of Citizenship**.

This is an important promise to:

- Respect Canada's laws.
- Fulfill the responsibilities of citizenship.
- Be loyal to Canada.
- Participate in Canadian society.

After taking the oath, you officially become a Canadian citizen.



Receive Your Citizenship Certificate

After completing the ceremony, you'll receive your **Canadian Citizenship Certificate**.

This certificate is official proof of your Canadian citizenship.

Store it in a safe place.

Apply for a Canadian Passport

After becoming a Canadian citizen, you may apply for a **Canadian passport**.

A Canadian passport allows Canadian citizens to travel internationally using one of the world's most widely recognized travel documents.

Participate in Canadian Democracy

As a Canadian citizen, you can participate more fully in Canada's democratic life.

If you meet the legal requirements, you may:

- Vote in elections.
- Become involved in community activities.
- Run for public office if eligible.
- Continue contributing to Canadian society.

Am I a citizen immediately after passing the test?

Passing the test is an important step, but citizenship is officially granted after you complete all required steps, including taking the Oath of Citizenship.

When will I receive my ceremony invitation?

The timing varies depending on your application and processing. IRCC will notify you when your ceremony is scheduled.

What should I do while waiting?

Continue checking your email and any official updates from IRCC, and make sure your contact information is current.

Can I apply for a Canadian passport after becoming a citizen?

Yes. After you become a Canadian citizen, you may apply for a Canadian passport.
